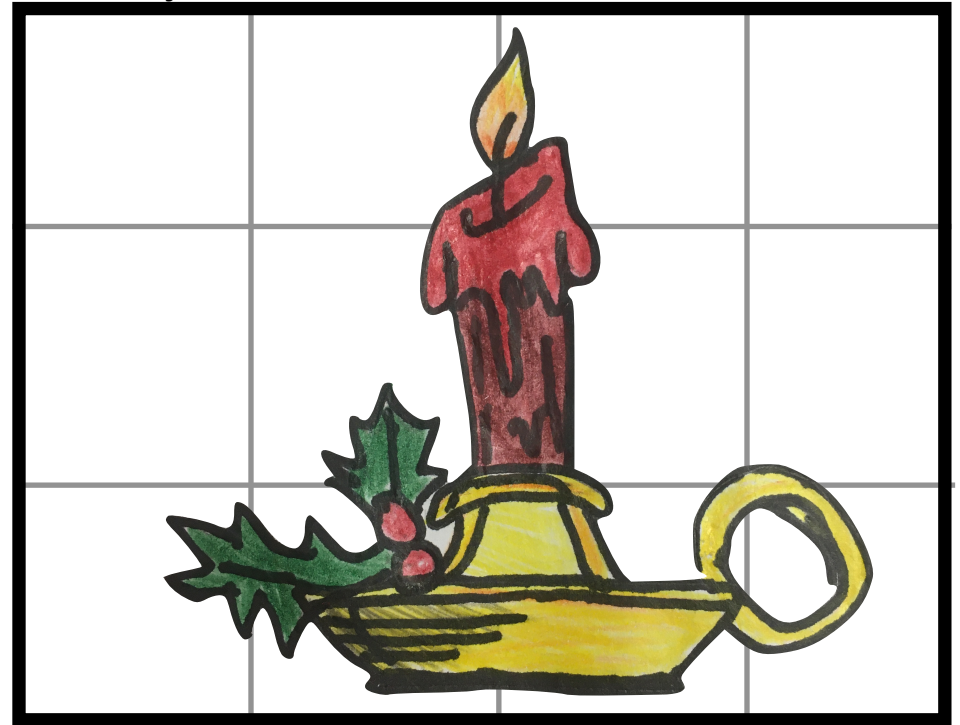
One of the many beautiful things about Christmas are candles. Candles represent light breaking through darkness.
